3.	Project proponent should establish Bag filters to control ash particles to less than 50mg/Nm <sup>3</sup>	The civil works for the project has been initiated from Jan 2021. We will comply with the condition during procurement of the equipment and boiler/thermic fluid heaters. However are rethinking on the use of briquettes to control fly ash issue that may be generated and we would be considering the use of LDO/NG
4.	Environment friendly fuels like Briquettes will be used.	We will comply with the condition; we have initiated the civil works for the project in Jan 2021. We are also looking into the possibility for use of LDO/HDS instead of Briquettes to avoid the dust menace that may be generated due to the fly ash We will take due permission from the MPCB in the regard.
5.	Project Proponent should establish vents, condensers so as to reduce Volatile Organic Compounds.	We shall comply with the condition once the plant is operational. The condition is considered at design stage of the project.
6.	Effluent shall be strictly treated in ETP and recycled. Treated waste water will be reused. For Fly ash/Coal Dust suppression, balance for cooling & gardening within the plant & remaining treated waste water will be sent to nearby common effluent treatment plant (CETP).	We will comply with the condition and the same has been considered during the design stage itself. Though CETP is not available in the region we will ensure Zero Liquid Discharge by installation of Water Evaporator and recycle of water for Cooling towers, Floor Washing, Vessel Washing, Gardening if allowed, Briquettes /Coal is being avoided to be used as fuel. We are considering use of LDO/HSD as fuel.
7.	Green belt should be established in the existing plot area. Minimum 200 trees should be planted in the premises with due maintenance up to 3 years by Project proponent.	Condition is Complied with the plantation of 286 tree saplings and we shall maintain the green zone as Environment Clearance and MPCB Norms once the civil works are completed.
